1. First of all, if you have purchased a H-D Motorcycle here, you are automatically enrolled in not only National H.O.G. but also Caliente H.O.G. for one year starting from the day of purchase. Just fill out the local H.O.G. paperwork given to you at the time of sale, return it, and BAM!!!... you are there! Or, you can fill out the membership application at www.calientehog.com/membership.html , print it out and leave it with the Caliente receptionist.

2. If you are outside this window, to join Caliente H.O.G., you have to first become, and must maintain, a National H.O.G. Membership. Go to <https://members.hog.com/> for information and details to join.
3. Once you have a National H.O.G. Membership, you can now join us. Go to www.calientehog.com/membership.html to get our local membership application. We charge a nominal \$25 yearly fee to cover our admin costs to run the Chapter. You can drop this off with the Caliente receptionist.
4. Swing by the dealership and attend the New Members Orientation. As an option, you can bring this form with you to this Orientation and we can get the form and payment from you then. The Orientation is an incredible resource for you to get you up and running with the Chapter. Bring your spouse/significant other as otherwise, you will be quizzed by them and there is no doubt, there will be a question that they want to know the answer to that YOU didn't ask. We run this Orientation in conjunction with our Chapter Meetings which are normally held the first Saturday of the month.
